

## SPANISH COURSE REQUEST FOR NON-SPANISH MAJORS for SPRING 10

Only Spanish Primary Majors are given priority during the early registration period. If you are **NOT** a Spanish major, including Spanish minor, you may try for classes on **Monday, November 30 at 9:00 AM**. This is when all registration blocks will be removed and any remaining seats in Spanish courses will become available.

If you are **not** a primary major **but** are in one of the **specific majors** listed below, you will click on the form link provided to request a course which will be activated beginning **Wednesday, October 21, 2009**. After you have done so, you will then be able to register at your appropriate ticket time for the courses you have requested. If you are available for more than one section, please list in order of priority.

Once you have submitted the form, do **not** wait more than three business days after your registration time before trying. **If you have problems**, then you should **e-mail me** the filled out form instead of submitting another form. I am usually able to process the forms within 3 business days if you have given **all of the pertinent information including the section numbers and letters**.

**If you need to change**, after you have initially registered for a Spanish course you have requested, you will then want to **send me an e-mail** with the same information (ex. UIN, CRN etc) as the form mentioning that you are requesting a change to a course for which you were already given an override. (Please try to keep these at a minimum and there are no guarantees for these changes). In this case, you will receive a response to your e-mail when I am able to process the change.

I will make every attempt to honor course requests for non-majors if you are:

- A DUAL OR SECONDARY MAJOR w/Spanish as second major (Approved by LAS)
- A MAJOR IN COMPARATIVE LITERATURE w/ Concentration in Spanish
- A MAJOR IN EDUCATION (Elem.Early,Pre-Teacher) w/ Concentration in Spanish/Advisor Todd Spinner or Kathy Ryan
